Stewardship of Time:

We all make time for what's important! Our annual stewardship renewal gives us the opportunity to reflect upon whether Christ is truly the center of our lives. In fact, the best way to show how thankful we are for God's mercy is by giving God our worship and thanks at Mass each Sunday and Holy Day.

Stewardship of Talent:

God's mercy flows to others when we share our talents. So many of our parishioners live out the corporal and spiritual works of mercy through their involvement with our parish ministries. Please take time to look over our service opportunity list of ministries in the parish and the many ways you can share your talents.

Stewardship of Treasure:

"Tithe" is a biblical standard for giving that is rooted in Scripture and exemplified in the lives of early Christians. The word "tithe" comes from "tenth" and used to indicate the portion of one's earnings that is set apart as first fruits for God.

Parishioners are asked to complete and return an operations pledge card each calendar year. Each family is asked to divide the biblical 10% of annual gross household income in the following manner:

- 5% to Parish Operations (Tithe)
- 4% to other worthy charities, which may include St. Francis de Sales Parish
- 1% to the Archbishops Call to Share
- Note: Xavier Catholic School families are encouraged to give this additional 4% to our parish in support of Xavier Catholic school if you are able.
