Volunteer Duties

HOST FAMILY

- Provide lodging for 2 missionaries for the week. (arrive Sat night leave Sat morning)
 - two beds are ideal, but a bed and a couch works too.
 - Due to Covid, it would be ideal if missionary had a designated bathroom that would be just for them for them.
- Provide continental style breakfast at 7:00 a.m. each morning
 - cereal, fruit, bagel, muffin, granola bar or toast is sufficient. Sometimes all the team may want is coffee.
- Missionaries leave between 7:30 and 8 each morning and often won't return until 10 pm.
- Missionaries will need access to laundry facilities, as they do not go home between parishes.
- Allow missionaries access to your washer and dryer if needed.
- Possibly be willing to drop missionaries off at the parish in the mornings. (Only one car per team.)

LUNCH PROVIDER

- Provide enough food for 4 missionaries + the parish coordinator, pastor and any all-day, on-site volunteers
 - Food allergies/restrictions will be communicated if there are any.
- Lunch needs to arrive at the parish by 11:45, to ensure it is ready and waiting for the team.

DINNER PROVIDER

- Provide dinner for 4 missionaries and the evening program participants (number varies by parish)
- Dinner should be buffet style and needs to be at the parish by 6:15 pm
- It can be homemade or bought/catered.

DINNER SET UP, SERVE & CLEAN UP

- Make sure tables and chairs are set up. Drinks are pre-poured, serve dinner then clean up.

CLASSROOM AIDE

- Assist with the day program classrooms.
- Duties may include but are not limited to: crowd control, passing out materials, clean up, getting materials, etc.

SNACK HELPER / KITCHEN HELPER

- Help setup snack and drinks for the morning, lunch and/or afternoon breaks.

POTLUCK VOLUNTEER

- Assist with setup, clean, up or serving of the food.
